



Sponsorship Opportunities to help the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sandhills

Jeremiah Millbank Society Champion – The Jeremiah Milbank Society is designed to encourage and promote individual giving to local Boys & Girls Clubs. It will recognize donors who make unrestricted annual gifts of \$10,000 or more to a local Club. Donation: \$10,000.

Annual Membership Guidelines for the Jeremiah Millbank Society Champion

- Annual membership is for individuals who make unrestricted cash gifts of \$10,000 or more to the Boys & Girls Club of the Sandhills
- Gifts are to be paid in one year, i.e. multi-year pledge payments totaling \$10,000 are not eligible. However, payments during the year that total \$10,000 or more are eligible.
- Donors can be recognized as individuals or as couples. For example, John Smith or Mr. and Mrs. John Smith can be recognized for membership as the result of one gift of \$10,000.

Annual Dinner Speaker Sponsor – This sponsor would be underwriting the cost of a well known speaker to be the keynote speaker at a fundraising dinner in 2012 that would take the place of the luncheon we are holding in 2011. This sponsor would get public recognition on the invitations to be mailed, press releases, thank you notes and posters and special recognition at the dinner. This includes a table for 8 at the dinner. \$10,000.

Keep the Buses Rolling Sponsor – This sponsor allows the Club to keep our two 24 seat buses, on the road taking our members. not only to field trips that involve fun and educational opportunities but to community service projects, for example when our members carried the signs for the US Kids Golf Parade and to the street the Club adopted for clean up. Sponsors are listed with their logos on the back of both of our buses for one year. \$5,000.

Club Champion Program – This program is designed for major donors whose giving level provides unrestricted operating support for the Club. Each donor is given tickets to every special event the Club sponsors and is recognized on our Club letterhead and in our newsletter. \$5,000.

Newsletter Sponsor – This program is for major donors who make a Club newsletter to the 6,500 households on our mailing list possible. The major sponsor is recognized in the publication on a ¼ page ad in the four page newsletter. The newsletter is designed to highlight activities at the Club, promote

special events and recruit volunteers. \$3,000 and above. This can be shared by two co-sponsors for \$1,500 each.

Pinestock Event Sponsor – This major sponsor would receive top billing at the third annual spring outdoor event held after SpringFest in downtown Southern Pines. The sponsor and their logo would be on all publicity concerning this popular and well attended event. Sponsorship includes 20 tickets which includes food and music. \$3,000.

Friend of the Club – This giving level is for individuals and businesses who want to participate at the \$2,500 giving level and includes listing on the Club letterhead and in the newsletter.

Annual Giving Kickoff Luncheon Sponsor – This sponsor would be underwriting the Annual Giving Kickoff Luncheon to be held this year at Forest Creek Country Club on Tues. Nov. 15st. The luncheon is designed to highlight the members of the Club, tell guests what the Club does for the members and the community and asks guests to consider a donation. This sponsorship would include a table of 8. \$2,500

Field Trip Sponsor – This sponsor allows 24 young people, who would not otherwise be able to go, to travel to the NC Aquarium for a day of fun and education. This sponsor would be recognized in a press release to The Pilot and in an article in our Club newsletter. \$1,000.

Program Sponsor- This sponsor can pick one of the many proven successful national Boys & Girls Clubs of American programs that the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sandhills operates on a weekly basis at the Club. Your Sponsorship purchases supplies for programs such as Power Hour, a homework tutoring program, Triple Play a program designed to help club members become healthy and fit; or Smart Moves, an education and prevention program addressing drug and alcohol use as well as premature sexual activity. Your business or name will be promoted at the sponsor of the particular program you choose in all media and on our letterhead for a year. \$1,000.

Technology Programs Sponsor- This sponsor will be helping to purchase computers, software, printers, iPads and accessories to provide our kids with access to technology needed to complete homework assignments. Many of our members do not have access to technology tools at home, so this sponsorship is a great one at an affordable donation price: \$50.00.

Art and School Supplies Sponsor: Throughout the year, the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sandhills implements a variety of art programs that require supplies such as construction and poster paper, pencils, crayons, paint, glue sticks, scissors, tape and a variety of supplies that will help children at the club AND that can be used at school if needed. Donation price: \$25.00.

Two Books for Youth Sponsor: The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sandhills is always striving to add more books to our library. For a small donation of \$5.00, you will help us buy two books, which does go a long way.
